 Suitable for dynamic skiing.

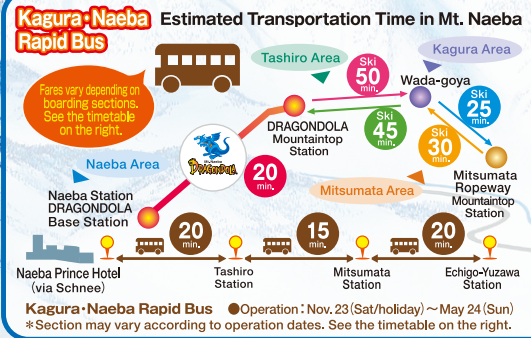
Mogul Trail
