We will charge you the expense for any rescue or search happened in (No Skiing Zones) regardless of any reasons.

Tsugaiko Kogen Ski Resort Rules & Regulations

For everyone who enjoys our ski resort, please follow the rules & regulations written.

- No skiing or snowboarding in prohibited areas as shown on both ski area and topographical maps. Avalanches can be easily be triggered. Missed trails as well as climbing slips and rock slides occur in this area. Prohibited area is out of our management, rescue operation or searches from the ski area cannot be made if you are outside of the marked trails. A climbing plan is required to submit in advance if you wish to go mountain climbing or backcountry skiing. Be aware of any wild grouse inhabiting mountainous regions and avalanche danger zones.
- It is prohibited to enter "No Skiing Zone", outside of marked or closed trails. You will be responsible for all expenses if any accident occurs out side of ski area boundaries that requires search or rescue operations.
- Please observe all posted signs, signboard, ropes and follow the instructions of the Ski Patrol.
- Difference in terrain, structures, ski slope condition, types of snow requires different abilities in skiing or snowboarding. It is your responsibility to not go beyond your capacity. Also be aware of the changing mountain weather conditions while you are out on the mountain.
- Please check your equipment before skiing or snowboarding.
- It is the responsibility of all guests to consider not only their own safety, but also the safety of others, at all times.
- If you are not sure of which areas are "No Skiing Zones" then please ask for instructions from the Ski Patrol.
- Drones are banned except with permission.
- Victims will be asked to leave the ski resort immediately and no refund will be made regardless of any reasons.

ALPINE Responsibility Code

Regardless of how you decide to enjoy the slopes, always show courtesy to others and be aware that there are elements of risk in snow recreational activities that common sense and personal awareness can help reduce, observe the 10-point code listed below and share with others the responsibility for a great experience.

- Always stay in control, and be able to stop or avoid other people or objects.
- Observe and obey all signs and warnings.
- Do not stop where you obstruct a trail, or are not visible from above.
- When starting downhill or entering a trail, look uphill and give way to others.
- Prior to using a lift, you must have the knowledge and ability to load, ride and unload safely. If in doubt, please ask a lift attendant.
- Keep off closed trails and out of closed areas.
- People ahead of you have the right of way. It is your responsibility to avoid them.
- Always use suitable restrains to prevent runaway equipment.
- Do not ski, board, ride a lift or undertake any other alpine activity if you ability is impaired by drugs or alcohol.
- If you are involved in, or witness an accident or collision, alert Ski Patrol, remain at the scene and identify yourself to the Ski Patrol.
