1. SNOW RESORT PROHIBITED AREAS

As mentioned on the map, DO NOT ski or ride in the prohibited terrain in the resort and the area outside a boundary line. Please do ask Ski Patrol or Authorized Personnel if it is not clear.

2. FREERIDING AREA "OMUSUBI"

OMUSUBI freeride area is limited to advanced and expert riders. Skiing/riding is permitted in this area only when the gate is open.

3. SEARCH and RESCUE FEES

If we support search and rescue operation outside the resort area, we shall request the payment of relevant expenses. This will also be adapted to an operation in the prohibited terrain in the resort.

4. GUESTS DUTIES and OBLIGATIONS

For your safety, we kindly request all guests to observe and follow any instructions from the resort management and the Ski Patrol. Please follow and practice the Hakuba Valley Safety Tips as part of your responsibility when visiting our resort.

5. MOUNTAIN CLIMBING and BACK COUNTRY SKIING

Please follow the relevant procedures before undertaking a mountain climbing and Backcountry skiing. Fill in and submit notification form registered with police. Trailheads are installed trailwads are mark "G".

6. DRONES are prohibited unless the operator obtains consent from the Happo-One snow resort management.

Refusal to abide by this agreement will immediately in cancellation or refusal to enter the resort. Any fees will not be refunded regardless of the reason.

7. REFUSAL TO ENTER

There are inherent dangers in snow sports, such as falls, collisions, poor weather conditions, and poor visibility. Please be aware of these dangers and enjoy your stay. The safety management of the snow resort corresponds to the Snow Sports Safety Standards established by the Japan Association of Skiing Safety (JASS).

HAKUBA VALLEY Safety Tips Snow Resort Safety Information

1. Pay attention to "boundary" and "closed area" signs
2. Control your speed while skiing or snowboarding
3. Pay attention to your surroundings and check the situation
4. Leashes are mandatory for snowboards
5. Wearing a helmet is highly recommended
6. Ski with friends in deep powder
7. Ski resorts are off limit outside operating hours
8. Violating rules at the ski resort will result in suspension of your lift ticket and you will be asked to leave the resort
9. Contact ski resort staff in an emergency
10. Check the Rules and Regulations of ski resorts for further information

ONLY HEATED TOBACCO ALLOWED

For all our visitors to enjoy more comfortable and clean environment, only heated tobaccos are allowed to use and combustible cigarettes are not allowed to use inside the ski resort*.
